**Lesson #:** 1-2**Lesson Title:** Sermon on the Mount/Let Your Light Shine

Scripture: Matthew 5-6

Memory Work:

**Teacher Asks:** What did Jesus teach?**Student Answers:** John 5:14&16 Ye are the light of the world... Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.**Goals and Objectives:****The children will learn that:**

- \*Jesus tells how to be a godly example to others that observe our behavior.
- \*Jesus says not to worry and believe God will provide.
- \*Jesus says to seek His kingdom and to please God.

**Application from Lesson:**

1. God takes care of us, so we must not worry about our food or clothing.
2. Nothing is beyond the power of Christ. We must trust God.
3. The blessings in our lives show how God loves us.

**Order of Activities and Songs:**

1. Let each student place attendance sticker on attendance/memory chart.
2. Sing "It is Time for Bible Class"

**Teacher Asks:** What did Jesus teach?**Student Answers:** John 5:14&16 Ye are the light of the world... Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.**Goals and Objectives:****The children will learn that:**

\*Jesus tells how to be part of God's kingdom.

\*Jesus says that listening to and obeying God's word makes a person wise.

\*the wise man built his house on Christ and the foolish man built his house on unwise things of this world.

**Application from Lesson:**

1. God wants to be the focus of our lives.
2. Building our lives and choices on Christ is wise.
3. If our hearts are built on Christ we will be able to face trials with faith.

**Teacher Asks:** What did Jesus teach?**Student Answers:** John 5:14&16 Ye are the light of the world... Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.**Goals and Objectives:****The children will learn that:**

\*Jesus is our shepherd.

\*if we follow the shepherd we will be saved.

\*Jesus, the good shepherd gives His life for His sheep.

\*some did not believe Jesus was the shepherd and thought he had a demon.

**Application from Lesson:**

1. Jesus is our shepherd and we are His sheep.
2. Jesus takes care of and protects those who love Him.
3. Jesus sacrificed His life for all people.
